BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

CA Election Codes Sections 14025 to 14032 require that school districts review census data every ten years. That review process includes the study of a) proportional representation and b) demographic analysis for verification that the existing voting model creates no impairment on the ability of any protected class to elect candidates of its choice or its ability to influence the outcome of the election.

REPORT/PROPOSAL:

A Public Hearing will include census analysis information from the Board Study Session on January 17, 2012 and is in preparation of February 14, 2012 Board action.

Proposal 1: Current boundaries

Proposal 2: Trustee Areas are divided by East-West running roads, with an emphasis on making the boundaries as straight and simple as possible.

Proposal 3: Trustee Areas are divided by North-South running roads, with an emphasis on making the boundaries as straight and simple as possible.

Proposal 4: Trustee Areas are reconfigured so that each area represents the same area of Yuba City as the current lines. Trustee Area one represents the south, Trustee area 2 represents the central-west, and Trustee Area 3 represents the North, and Central-East areas.

Proposal 5: Trustee Areas are configured so that no Trustees are moved out of their areas.
